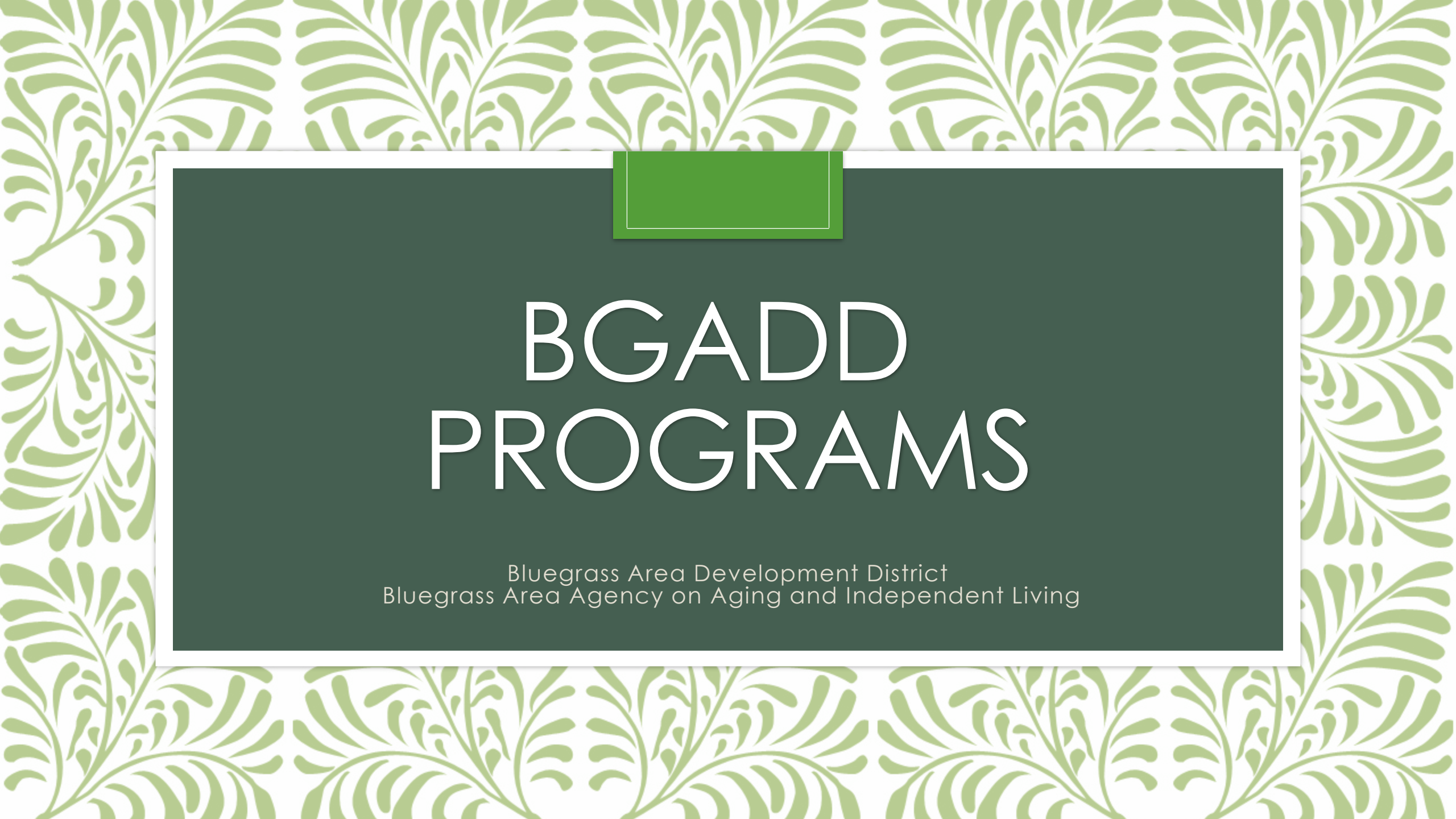

Popular Programs

Senior Nutrition Program

- Senior Nutrition Program—Home Delivered Meals
- Free to anyone 60+ who does not drive and does not have a driver in the home.
- Congregate meals are free to anyone 60+ who does drive or can come to the center to enjoy the meals if transportation is provided.
- Most counties currently have a significant waiting list.

National Family Caregiver Support Program

- For caregivers of individuals 60 + or 55+ if living with dementia
- Provides 90-100 hours of respite (approx. \$2100/year and \$500/year for incontinence supplies, nutritional supplement drinks, or small pieces of medical equipment)
- Currently, there is a 4-5 month waiting list for these services

Popular Programs

Homecare

- For individuals aged 60+ who do NOT qualify for the Waiver, either based on income or LOC guidelines
- Price for services is based on a sliding scale fee based on monthly income
- Typically, there are less hours of service provided (10-20/week)
- Currently, there is an 8-12 month waiting list for this program

Medicaid Waiver Programs

- Client must be at a nursing home level of care and have a documented physical disability
- Client must make less than \$2,901/month and have less than \$2000 in assets and resources in order to meet financial eligibility
- Has different types of programs; Acquired Brain Injury—Acute or Long Term, Support for Community Living, Michelle P Waiver, Home and Community Based Waiver, Model II, CHILD, I-RISE

ADRC Process

Referrals can be made by

- Leaving a confidential voicemail at 866-665-7921
- Emailing adrc@bgadd.org and using the referral sheet to include necessary information.
- Calls will be returned in the order in which they were received
- Can include a completed Waiver application, MAP 10 and MAP 115 along with the initial referral
- Our Resource Specialist will call to assess whether the client meets LOC for Waiver
- If client has active Medicaid we can start the application that day. MAP 10 and MAP 115 will also be required along with other supporting documents to complete application
- If client does not have active Medicaid, he or she must contact DCBS and ask to start an application for “Waiver Supportive Medicaid”, NOT traditional Medicaid
- Medicaid for HCBW looks at individual’s income ONLY, not household

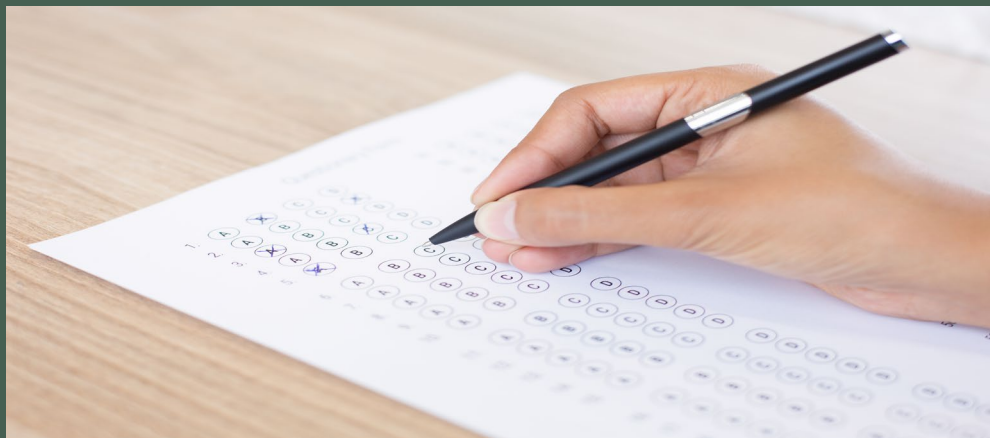

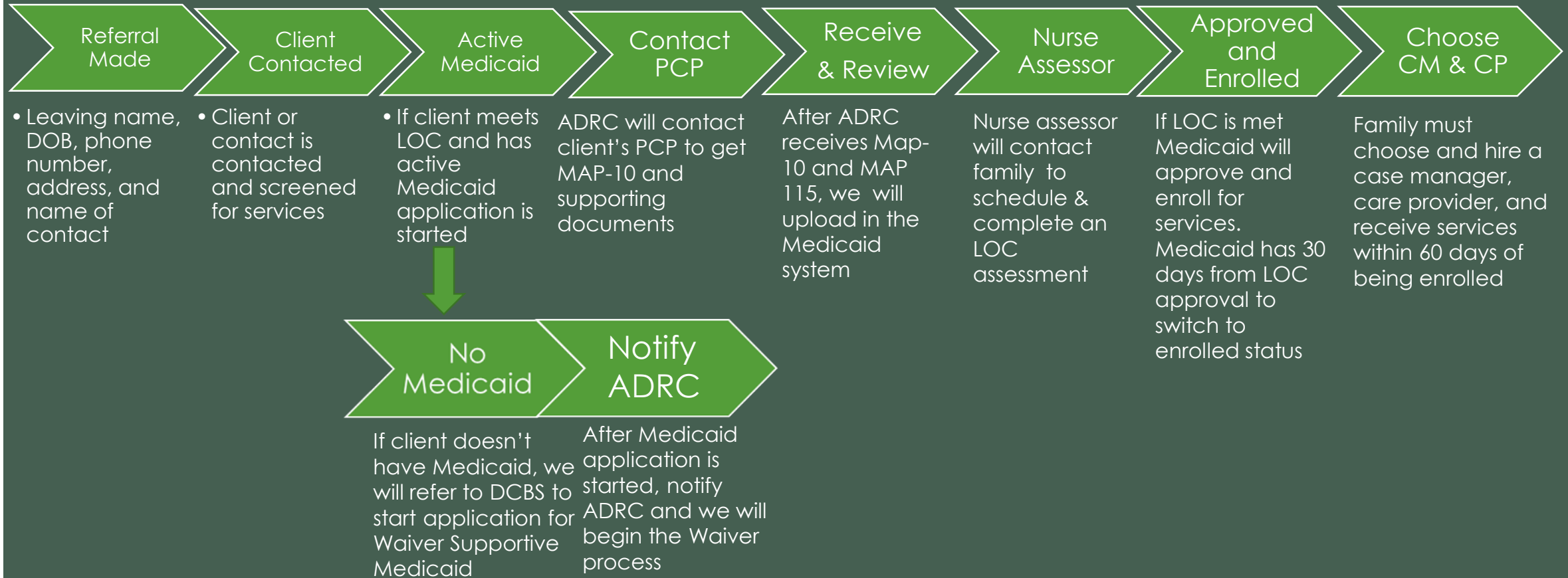

HCBW Process Steps



Medicaid Waiver Programs

Michelle P

- Intellectual or developmental disabilities
- Diagnosis before age 18
- Very long waiting list (6-8 years)
- Assists with day training, environmental adaptations, personal care, and respite
- Needs a signed Map-10, psychological assessment, MAP 115 and supporting documents

Home and Community Based Waiver

- Physical disability documented – Any age
- Quicker access to services, although current waiting list is 10-12 months.
- Assists with ADL's and IADL's; bathing, dressing, grooming, chores, transportation – NON-SKILLED needs only
- Needs a signed Map-10, MAP 115 and supporting documents, depending on client's application

Medicaid Waiver Programs

Support for Community Living

- Must have Intellectual and/or developmental disability
- Meet the requirements for residence in a care facility
- Offers environmental accessibility adaptation, vehicle adaptation, personal assistance, residential support services
- Needs Map-10, psychological assessment, MAP 115 and supporting documents
- Waiting list is long (6-8 years) Does have an emergency option

Acquired Brain Injury

- Must have acquired brain injury diagnosis after age 18
- Needs discharge summary, Map-10, MAP 115, and other supporting documents
- Acute—have potential for rehab and retraining
- Long Term Care-have reached plateau and need maintenance
- Services Provided: adult day, training, respite, companion services, community living support, personal care, nursing supports
- LOC Assessment completed by outside agency

Type of Services Under Waiver

Traditional Services

- Receive services through an agency
- Agency has provided training, background checks, and safety measures
- Can start with traditional services then switch to PDS when case management becomes available
- A case manager must be obtained within 60 days of enrollment in Waiver

Participant Directed Services

- Family member or friend, once approved by Medicaid, can be paid as the caregiver
- Used to be called CDO (Consumer Directed Option)
- BGADD offers PDS case management for the MPW and the HCBW. New Vista offers PDS option for ABI and SCL Waiver. Model II, CHILD and I-Rise Waivers do not offer a PDS option.
- Proposed caregiver must pass criminal background check and client may require CPR training/ TB test, etc.



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
